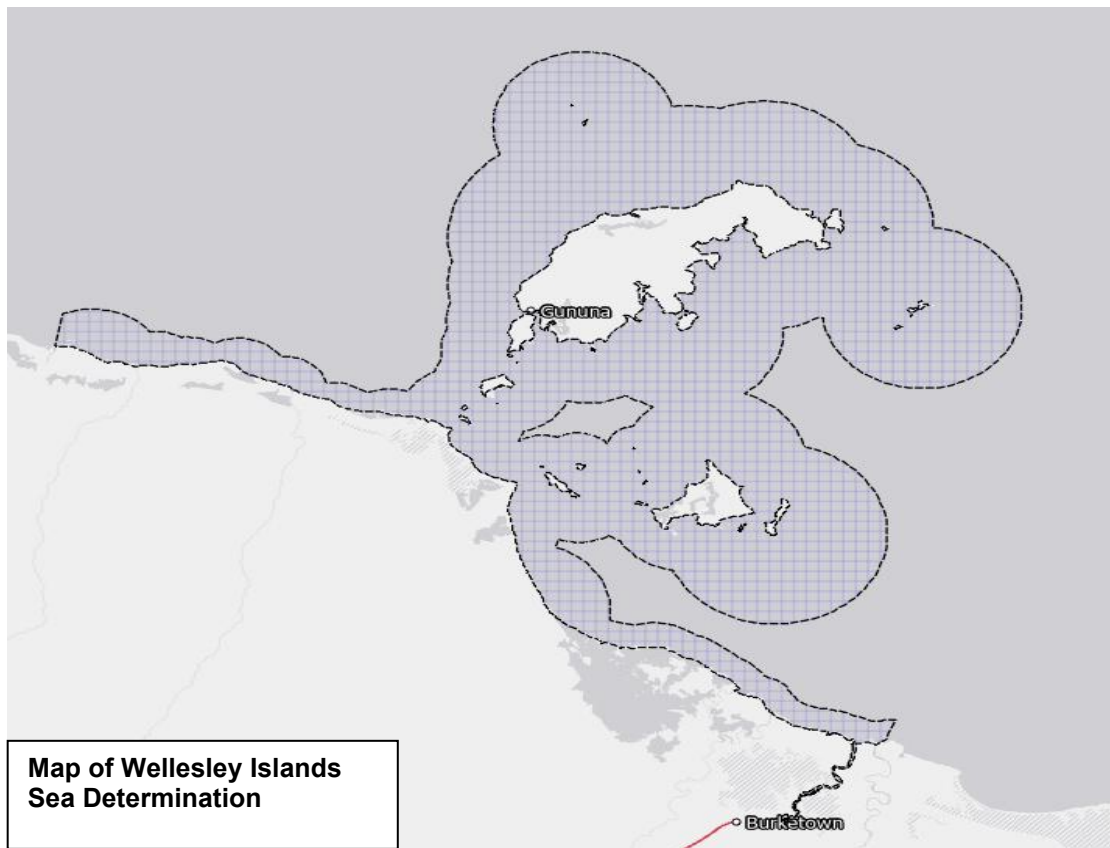
NOTICE OF LARDIL, YANGKAAL, GANGALIDDA AND KAIADILT PEOPLES COMMUNITY MEETING

Information meetings regarding a possible variation of the Wellesley Island Sea Determination

Information to be presented

The community meeting has been called in accordance with rule 14 of the Constitution of the Gulf Region Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC. The meeting will provide information to native title holders regarding a proposed variation of the *Lardil Peoples v State of Queensland* [2004] FCA 298 (**Wellesley Islands Sea Determination**) to allow for native title holders to take resources for any purpose within the determination area. Currently, the native title holders may only take resources for personal, domestic or non-commercial consumption.
